- 1- Continuous stay of 3 years
- 2- Clean criminal record
- 3- Labour contract
- 4- Family Ties with Residence Permit holders.
 - Direct ascendants
 - Direct descendants
 - Spouse

SOCIAL ROOTS (SOCIAL REPORT)

Art. 45.2 b Reloex

- 1- Continuous stay of 3 years
- 2- Clean criminal record
- 3- Labour contract
- 4- Social Report issued by the Council's Social Services.
 - Length of continuous stay
 - Means of living
 - Degree of knowledge of Basque and Spanish
 - Integration in surrounding social networks
 - Participation in socio-labour integration programmes
 - Any other activities or circumstances useful to determine the degree of social roots.

RECOMMENDATION FOR WORK EXEMPTION

Art. 45.2 b Reloex

- 1- Continuous stay of 3 years
- 2- Clean criminal record
- 3- Family Ties OR report substantiating social integration issued by the Council's Social Services.
- 4- Recommendation for exemption from Labour Contract requirement

Grounds:

- Health reasons or physical incapacity, disability, etc.
- Family: dependent relatives or minor children in their care.
- Age, etc.

Proof of sufficient means of living:

- Individual and family monthly income

BUILD YOUR ROOTS

- Contact the Social Services upon your arrival
- Take part in insertion or Training programmes
- Take part in Basque and Spanish courses (Aisa Programme, etc)
- Remember what organisations and/or public or private associations you have contacted
- Keep all the documentation that substantiates your stay since your entry in the country: passport, airline tickets, registration in municipal padrones (censuses), reports (medical, social etc.), rental agreements and rental documents, bank accounts, etc.

Extra-community citizens registered in the municipal padrón (census)
